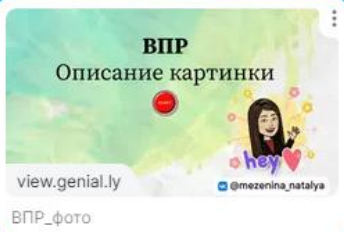

Captain James Cook was an English explorer, navigator and cartographer. He made three voyages to the Pacific Ocean, mapping many areas and recording several islands and coastlines on European maps for the first time. He is most notable for the British finding the east coast of Australia, finding the Hawaiian Islands and the first mapping of Newfoundland and New Zealand.

It is interesting to mention that by 1792, Cook had risen to a position of mate. In 1795, he was offered a command of a cutter, but he turned down the offer. In mid-1795, he made an unusual decision of volunteering in the Navy as an ordinary sailor.

During his lifetime, he sailed twice around the world. He crossed the Antarctic Circle and found new islands and landscapes in North America and the South Pacific. During his trips, he spent a lot of time on science experiments, and mapping new areas. He also wrote a lot of books about what he found.
